Students who have not yet completed the Simmons PLAN (general education) or who will not have the 128 credits Simmons requires to graduate will need to take additional coursework during their nursing sequence in order to fulfill their graduation requirements.

International students who need 12 credits per semester for their student visa must take additional courses to reach the 12 required credits, even if they have already fulfilled their graduation requirements.

Prerequisites for the 2-Year Sequence

All prerequisites are required with a grade of C+ or higher before you can start the accelerated sequence. Final transcripts reflecting this are due on August 1st for a September start. Prerequisites must have been completed in the past ten years.

The prerequisites are:

1. Inorganic Chemistry (fulfilled by CHEM 110 or CHEM 111) **OR** Organic Chemistry (fulfilled by CHEM 110 or CHEM 112)
2. Anatomy and Physiology I (fulfilled by BIO 231)
3. Psychology (fulfilled by AP/IB credit, or PSYC 101)
4. Microbiology (fulfilled by BIOL 123 or BIOL 221)
5. Anatomy and Physiology II (fulfilled by BIOL 232)
6. Lifespan Psychology (fulfilled by PSYC 235 or PSYC 237N)

Retake and Withdraw Policy

- Students who do not achieve the C+ on their first attempt at a prerequisite or nursing department course may retake that course only once.
- Students may not withdraw from more than one prerequisite or nursing department course (except for medical withdraws or other withdraws outside of the student's control).
- All prerequisite and nursing course retakes withdraws should be explained in the essay/ personal statement.
- Students exceeding one prerequisite retake or exceeding one prerequisite withdraw within the past 10 years are not eligible for the Simmons BSN program.
- Students who have been excluded from another nursing program or who have retaken or withdrawn from more than one nursing department course are not eligible for the Simmons BSN program.

Curriculum Policy

- Prerequisite courses must be taken at a regionally-accredited institution and may be completed online or in person.
- If you have taken a Child and Adolescent Development course you may also need to take Human Growth & Development. Your Development coursework must cover the entire lifecycle from birth to death; however, courses may be combined (for example, one semester of Child and Adolescent Development and one semester of Adult and Elder Development) to fulfill the prerequisite.
- With the exception of the two Psychology courses and Statistics, all prerequisites must include a lab.

Admission Policy

- You may apply prior to completing your prerequisites.
- You may apply to take your prerequisites in the spring, summer, and fall terms. Simmons prerequisite courses are offered throughout the year, but the selection of courses offered may differ by semester. Therefore, it is important to check the Simmons course schedule. Generally, the schedule is posted ten weeks prior to the start of the new semester. Note that the summer schedule includes courses for the two summer sessions.
