

Undergraduate Nursing Options Available to Dix Scholars at Simmons College

The following grids outline the three options for the undergraduate nursing programs available to Dix Scholars. **Only the nursing courses are listed**, as each individual's schedule will vary depending on remaining prerequisite courses and the transcript evaluation of previous coursework.

18 Month Option – *Only students with a previous bachelor's degree who have successfully completed all prerequisite courses within the last 10 years are eligible. This sequence is accelerated, full-time and commences only in the summer.*
