As an entrepreneur, Kathy co-founded not only Circles, but also Spire, an on-line, invitation-only, dynamic, innovative and interactive lifestyle resource dedicated to the best life has to offer. Originally formed as a subsidiary of Circles, Spire was spun out in connection with the acquisition of Circles by Sodexo.

Kathy is a director of Circles, Spire, RAW Art and the Commonwealth Institute.
