

## ***Boston Cost of Living***

### **FIXED FEES**

\* Fixed fees must be paid by all accepted dietetic interns. On campus room and board, the health center fee and health insurance purchased through Simmons College are only required by students that elect to live on campus and do not have an alternate health insurance plan. Health insurance is required by all accepted dietetic interns.

*Health insurance fees	\$2,630/yr. if you are enrolled in 9 credit hours; this can be waived if you have your own health insurance.

### **BUDGET ALLOWANCES**

These fees are not directly billed, but should be considered when estimating the total financial commitment of the dietetic internship program.
