**FT = Full time and PT = Part time (5 credits per sem. for low-interest federal loans). The length of time indicated also assumes that all prerequisites have been completed, except for Direct Entry Nursing.

*** All earned degrees must have been completed at a regionally accredited post-secondary U.S. institution or a post-secondary institution abroad which is recognized by the Ministry of Education in the home country.

****All science prerequisites must include labs, with the exception of exercise physiology for the DPT program; courses must be equivalent to one semester in length (no single quarter or trimester courses). All prerequisites must have been completed within 10 years before the designated deadline dates at a regionally accredited U.S. college or university or at a post-secondary institution abroad which is recognized by the Ministry of Education in the home country. Exception to the ten year policy: statistics must have been taken within 5 years prior to the application deadline for D.N.P. and D.P.T. Bridge. Such courses must be graded: pass/fail/audit courses (courses repeated more than two times for DPT), and IB, CLEP and AP (Advanced Placement) scores do not fulfill prerequisites. For DE nursing, Developmental Psychology must span human development from birth to death, either in one course or a combination of courses.

***** Tuition is charged per credit hour; increases each year are determined in the spring for the following academic year beginning in Sept.

***** Potential HCA students may waive the GRE/GMAT by successfully completing (earning a grade of B or better) in HCA 500 and HCA 501; then, may formally apply to the MHA program. HCA 500 & HCA 501 are not offered in the summer.
