***All earned degrees must have been awarded by an accredited U.S. or overseas higher education institution recognized by the Ministry of Education in the home country.

****All science prerequisites must include labs, with the exception of exercise physiology. All prerequisites are one semester (not trimester or quarter-hour courses.) For full information and course descriptions, see the prerequisites page. All prerequisite courses must have been completed within that past ten consecutive years at an accredited U.S. or overseas higher education institution recognized by the Ministry of Education in the home country. These courses must be graded and may not be completed on a pass/fail basis or audited. Please note that a course in Developmental Psychology must cover human development from birth through death.

*****Tuition is calculated per credit hour. See Tuition and Fees on the SHS website for current tuition per credit hour & fees. Tuition increases slightly each May.

*****Students may waive GRE or GMAT requirement for M.H.A. program by successfully completing the HCA 500 & HCA 501 courses with a grade of B+ or better. Students with a nursing background (RN) may waive GRE requirement for the M.S. program in Nursing by successfully completing NUR 404, Normal and Abnormal Human Physiology, with a grade of B or better. NUR 404 is offered only in the fall (September) semester.
