**FIXED FEES**

Fixed fees must be paid by all accepted/enrolled SHS students, including dietetic interns. Campus room and board, health center fee, and health insurance purchased through Simmons College are only required of students that elect to live on campus and who do not have an alternate health insurance plan. Health insurance is required for all accepted/enrolled students.
