### **Radha Basu**

Radha Basu is a multi-talented, global woman leader who has expressed her entrepreneurial spirit successfully in the corporate, new venture and philanthropic spheres. ### **April E. Evans, Partner and Chief Financial Officer of Monitor Clipper Partners**

April E. Evans is Partner and Chief Financial Officer of Monitor Clipper Partners, a \$2 billion private equity firm. Previously, Ms. Evans was Partner and CFO of Advanced Technology Ventures. Prior to that, Ms. Evans was a Founding Partner with the accounting firm Squillace & Evans. Ms. Evans has also held senior finance and operations positions with Falcon Partners Management, BBK, Harvard Student Agencies, PricewaterhouseCoopers, and in the Harvard Medical School teaching hospital system.

Ms. Evans, a certified public accountant, received her M.B.A. with honors from Simmons College, two masters degrees with honors from Boston University, and her B.A. cum laude from Duke University. Ms. Evans is currently a director of the Private Equity CFO Association and a member of the Business Advisory Council for the Simmons College Graduate School of Management. She has also been active with the Kauffman Fellows Program of the Center for Venture Education, a member of the Emerging CEOs Steering Committee of The Commonwealth Institute, has served on the Advisory Committee to the Center for Women and Enterprise Venture Center, and has been an Assistant Professor at the Simmons College Graduate School of Management. Ms. Evans is a frequent speaker at industry conferences.

**Neal Yanovsky, CEO of Wireless Toyz**

Neal Yanovsky is CEO of Wireless Toyz, the largest specialty retailer of mobile phones and service in the U.S. Prior to joining Wireless Toyz, Neal was President of Panera Bread, an operator and franchisor of more than 1200 bakery. Earlier in his career, Yanovsky served at Fidelity Capital, where he formed and managed a group investing predominantly in early-stage health care technology companies, and was the senior marketing officer for Au Bon Pain, a chain of bakery cafes, during its period of most rapid growth.

Yanovsky is a graduate of Harvard College and Harvard Business School, and was a postgraduate research fellow at London School of Economics. He teaches at the Simmons Graduate School of Management, serves on the board of directors of the West End House Boys and Girls Club, and is a member of the Collections Committee of the Harvard Art Museum.
