¹Research, SW441 is offered in fall, spring and summer terms. It must be completed prior to enrollment in Evaluation, SW509.

²Racism, SW409 is offered fall, spring and summer terms. It can be taken any semester prior to the start of year III.

³SW with Groups, SW 577 is taken in Year II or III (OYO only).

⁴Social Action Elective can be taken any semester after both semesters of Social Policy, SW401 are completed.

⁵Assessment and Diagnosis, 414 can be taken in the summer or fall terms after completion of SW Practice, 421.

⁶SW424 and SW509 must be taken concurrently with the Year 3 Field Education, SW 547.

⁷All field placements must commence in September and be concurrent with a clinical practice course *each* semester. Field placements are 4 days/week, September – May OR 3 days/week, September – July (992 hours).

⁸Clinical Practice Elective must be taken concurrently with the spring term of Year 3 Field Education, SW 547.

⁹Students extending placement through summer *must save an elective* to take concurrently with the summer field placement.

¹⁰66 credits are required for graduation.

¹¹SW 402, Technology Competencies, and SW 40, Field Workshop, are non-credit and a mandatory part of the program.

Note: Urban Leadership students must take SW451 in spring semester of Year II and take SW452 in spring semester of year III.
