Simmons College School of Management’s MBA Programs Ranked #1 “Greatest Opportunity For Women” in the Nation by The Princeton Review

BOSTON (December 3, 2015) – For a seventh consecutive year, the Simmons College School of Management has been named the No. 1 MBA program with the “[Greatest Opportunity for Women](#)” by The Princeton Review. The ranking is part of the Princeton Review’s 2016 guidebook for “Best 295 Business Schools” based on student surveys.

The Princeton Review surveyed 22,000 students attending the 295 business schools. The 80-question survey asked students to rate their schools on several topics and report on their experiences.
