**Graduate-level course

Prerequisites for the Accelerated Nursing Sequence

Number of credits required for graduation (including transfer credits and credits in the nursing sequence): 128.

All prerequisites are required with a grade of C+ or higher before you can start the accelerated sequence. The math competency requirement must be completed through transfer credit or by exam.

The prerequisites are:

1. General Biology (fulfilled by AP/IB credit, BIOL 113 or BIOL 123; waived if you have confirmed approval to transfer in A&P I and II as well as Microbiology)
2. Inorganic Chemistry (fulfilled by CHEM 110, CHEM 111, or NURS 439)
3. Organic Chemistry (fulfilled by CHEM 110, CHEM 112, or NURS 439)
4. Anatomy and Physiology I (fulfilled by BIO 231 or NURS 431)
5. Psychology (fulfilled by AP/IB credit, PSYC 101)
6. Microbiology (fulfilled by BIOL 123, BIOL 221, or NURS 421)
7. Anatomy and Physiology II (fulfilled by BIOL 232 or NURS 431 + NURS 404)
8. Lifespan Psychology (fulfilled by PSYC 235 or PSYC 237N)
9. Statistics (fulfilled by MATH 118)*

*Statistics will be required starting in 2018

Retake Policy

- Students who do not achieve the C+ may retake that course only once.
- Students may not retake more than one prerequisite.
- Students exceeding the allowed retakes within the past 10 years are not eligible for the program.
- Students from other nursing programs who have had to retake more than one nursing department class are not eligible for the program.
- Withdrawn courses do not count as a retake, but should be addressed in your application.
