

Requirements to Transfer from Mills College to Simmons University Nursing Program

- 1. TEAS score of 80% or higher on each section
- 2. Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- 3. Prerequisite GPA of 3.0 or higher
- 4. C+ or higher in each prerequisite, with no more than one retake, as follows:
 - a. BIO 10N Introduction to Biology for Health Sciences (with lab)
 - b. CHEM 037N Organic and Biological Chemistry (with lab)
 - c. BIO 31N Human Anatomy for Nurses (with lab)
 - d. BIO 34N Human Physiology for Nurses (with lab)
 - e. BIO 41N Microbiology for Nurses (with lab)
 - f. PSYC 049 Fundamentals of Psychology
 - g. PSYC 040 Life-Span Development Psychology
- 5. C or higher in each Simmons PLAN course (general education) as follows:
 - a. ENG 001 Critical Reading and Expository Writing
 - b. Any Mills Written and Oral Communication II course
 - c. MATH 003 Pre-Calculus
 - d. PHIL 015 Introduction to Philosophy or PHIL 062 Ethics
 - e. Any Mills Race, Power, and Gender course
 - f. Any Mills Creativity, Innovation, and Experimentation course
 - g. 2 semesters of the same world language (strongly recommended to be completed before transferring for ease of clinical scheduling) *
- 6. Other Mills courses (required to earn a Pre-Nursing certificate, not required to transfer)
 - a. BIO 047N Introduction to Statistics and Analytical Methods for Nurses
 - b. CHEM 017 General Chemistry I
 - c. CHEM 038N Survey of Chemistry II: Principles of Nutrition for Nurses
 - d. COLL 005 Information Literacy/ Information Technology Skills
 - e. SOC 055 Introduction to Sociology

Students who do not meet the requirements are still encouraged to apply, and will be considered for admission on a case-by-case basis.
