International Credit Equivalencies

If you are planning to go abroad at the following locations, please note that a different credit system is utilized. Below is the US credit conversion. Approved international 3 credit courses will transfer as a full Simmons course, and will contribute 3 credits towards the 128 total credit requirement for graduation.

Europe: 5 ECTS= 3 US Credits

Japan: 10.5 credits = 3 / 4 US Credits

UK: 10 CATS = 3 US Credits
15 CATS = 4 US Credits
