

## **Honors Curriculum Updated Summer 2019**

**\*\*Please note that this curriculum is the same for non-nursing and nursing majors, with one exception: nursing majors will take a Boston course in the first year and their LC in the second year.\*\***

### **Class of 2020 and Class of 2021**

#### **Year One**

- SIM 101: The Simmons Course: Explore (Fall, 2 credits)
- Learning Community (Fall, 8 credits)
- Honors Leadership Course (Spring, 4 credits)
- Honors 190: “Talking in the 21st Century” (Spring, 1 credit)

#### **Year Two**

- SIM 201: The Simmons Course: Experience (Fall or Spring, 1 credit)
- Honors 290: Honors Global Scholars (Fall or Spring, no credit)
- Honors Global Cultural (GC) KCA (Fall or Spring, 4 credits)
  - Note that this is the ideal sequence, but due to scheduling issues some members of the Class of 2021 and possibly even 2020 have exceptions and took two honorific courses (SCI, SH, ALA, or QL) instead of an HON GC and one other honorific course.

#### **Year Three**

- SIM 301: The Simmons Course: Excel (Fall or Spring, 1 credit, online)
- 3D – Design Across Diverse Disciplines
  - Third and fourth years, 12 credits
  - Two of the three 3D courses must be at the 200 level or above

#### **Year Four**

- Honors Capstone Project
  - HON 395 (Fall, no credit, online)

Additionally, one of the four remaining Key Content Areas (SCI, SH, ALA, or QL) must be completed through an Honors-designated (“Honorific”) course.
