

Notes

- The French major requires at least 32 semester hours.
- Studying abroad is encouraged, but students are expected to take a minimum of 16 credits in the department, including at least 4 credits upon their return from study abroad. Otherwise, students are expected to take all classes for the major at Simmons with the possibility of transferring courses by petition and only in extreme hardship.
- No more than 4 credits of departmental courses given in English may be credited toward the major.
- Proficiency in a second modern language beyond the intermediate level is strongly recommended.
- French Education candidates have to take FREN 310 & FREN 311 as part of the licensure requirement.
