- Students must pass all science pre-requisites with a C+ or higher before taking Nursing courses. Students are allowed to retake one science pre-requisite, one time.
- All Key Content Areas (KCAs) and the Quantitative Literacy (QL) PLAN requirement are fulfilled through the Nursing Program, except for Aesthetic, Literary, and Artistic (ALA) Key Content Area. Please plan to take an ALA course when you have Elective/KCA in year three or four.
- For Nursing majors interested a full semester of studying abroad, please speak with your PLAN Advisor. The fall semester of junior year is the only semester that will accommodate a full semester abroad.
