## All students who participate in face-to-face learning are required to be tested for COVID-19 once per week

- Testing takes place in the Linda K. Paresky Conference Center,
   3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the MCB (A Building).
- Schedule your test via CoVerified (app or website).





#### Positive COVID-19 Cases

- If you test positive through the campus Health Center, you will be notified by the Health Center with instructions for isolation.
   Your faculty will also be notified.
- If you test positive at an outside testing site, please notify the Health Center immediately.
- If a student tests positive in one of your courses your faculty member will be notified and there will be a notification sent to everyone in the class with details for how to stay healthy. If you have a medical or religious exemption on file, you will receive a direct contact from the Health Center.
