## First Years | STEP 1: ASSESSMENT

<b>Get to know yourself</b> - Begin to identify your values, interests, skills, personality traits and career satisfiers in order to identify the ingredients of a good career "fit":
<ul> <li>□ Review the First Year Career Booklet</li> <li>□ Take self and personality assessments (Clifton Strengths Finder and CEC Assessments)</li> <li>□ Meet with a career coach to review assessments and early career planning</li> <li>□ Begin to identify career fields and/or academic programs that fit your interests and abilities</li> <li>□ Create a draft resume</li> <li>□ Complete your Handshake profile</li> </ul>
Sophomores   STEP 2: EXPLORATION
<b>Explore and research career possibilities -</b> Learn the connections between academic programs, experiential learning, previous professional experiences, and careers:
<ul> <li>Conduct career research and gather information from valuable online resources. Gather information on different fields, industries and companies</li> <li>Decide on a major and learn what career paths a major can offer</li> <li>Conduct informational interviews with people in fields that interest you</li> <li>Explore opportunities to gain relevant work experience, such as internships, summer jobs, or volunteer work</li> <li>Attend career and networking events</li> </ul>
Juniors   STEP 3: PREPARATION
Develop your resume and cover letter writing skills; refine your career goals and strategy - Through informational interviewing, internships, and relevant part-time and summer jobs, "test the waters" and determine a potential career direction:
<ul> <li>□ Update and tailor your resume and cover letter</li> <li>□ Research graduate schools and visit campuses</li> <li>□ Learn to present your strengths and goals in an elevator pitch</li> <li>□ Conduct informational interviews and build your network</li> <li>□ Develop and practice your interview skills</li> <li>□ Obtain an Internship</li> </ul>

## Seniors | STEP 4: IMPLEMENTATION

<b>Develop and implement your job search or graduate school strategy -</b> Develop the skills you need to accomplish your goals:
<ul> <li>Sharpen your job search skills and develop a list of potential employers</li> <li>Explore relevant job boards and begin to apply for jobs</li> <li>Prepare for interviews and practice interviewing skills with a mock interview</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Network with friends, parents, faculty, alumnae/i and others</li> <li>Gather graduate school application materials and write a personal statement</li> <li>Attend events such as career fairs, company presentations and career-related forums with alumnae/i</li> </ul>
Seniors   STEP 5: DECISION MAKING
