#### 1) Connect With Us

## 2) Submit a FAFSA

Many MSW students fund their education with the help of student loans. #### 3) Submit Tuition Deposit

Submit a \$300 deposit in your application portal. The deposit is non-refundable and will be applied to your first semester's tuition.

Once you pay your deposit, we will begin to send you new student information on course registration instructions, orientation, advising, and more.

# 1) Set Up Your Simmons Account and Password
